Student Assessment Data - Includes the following four assessments: M-STEP (Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress), College Board PSAT, and College Board SAT. This report section presents assessment information for English language arts and mathematics for grades 3 to 8 and 11, compared to state averages for all students as well as subgroups of students. The report helps users to understand achievement performance within grades and schools, and to make comparisons to district, state, and national achievement benchmarks.

Review the table below listing our schools. For the 2021-2022 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all



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schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. ABTE was identified in 2018-19 and for 2019 and 2020 school years index data was not available due to the waiver of federal accountability reporting requirements. In these cases, no status label is given. ABT MS/HS has been identified with the label CSI.
