

School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for The Academy for Business & Technology Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

During the 2021-2022 school year, the Academy transitioned fully in-person. For the previous school year, students participated in a virtual or hybrid program due to the global pandemic. Some of our greatest challenges were as follows: 1.) It was difficult for some students to transition from virtual learning to in-person learning after being home for two years. 2.) Another challenge was the learning gap that students had due to the global pandemic. 3.) Attendance was also a major concern. Students were out due to COVID and other illnesses throughout the school year. These challenges impacted student learning during the 2021-2022 school year.

Some of our key initiatives to close the achievement gap are as follows: 1.) We have continued with the implementation of the Multi-Tiered-Systems of Support (MTSS) Program. The MTSS program will continue to include mathematics and reading and the delivery system is characterized by individual and small group instruction during "tier time." 2.) The addition of standards-based quarterly assessments now in their fifth year will help to ensure that all of the State Common Core Standards are included in the instruction process. 3.) And, finally, we are continuing with the implementation of Instructional Learning Cycles (ILC) that will provide for re-teaching of those standards for which evidence shows low levels of student achievement.

State law requires that we also report additional information:

1. Process for assigning students to the school

- The Academy for Business & Technology is a free, public school and adheres to all requirements outlined by its charter authorizer and federal and state law regarding enrollments.
- The academy does not charge tuition nor discriminate in admissions policies or practices on the basis of intellectual or athletic ability, measures of achievement or aptitude, status as a handicapped person, religion, creed, race, sex, color or national origin.
- Current students are given the opportunity to re-enroll in late winter, with preference given to them and their siblings.
- In the spring, the school holds an advertised open enrollment period, during which any Michigan resident may apply.
- In the event that any grade is oversubscribed, a public lottery is held to determine enrollment and a waiting list.
- The academy identifies, evaluates and services all children in the school who may have disabilities. For more information regarding assistance for students with disabilities or if you suspect your child may have a disability, please contact the school leader.

2. The Status of the 3-5 year school improvement plan

The school improvement plan was developed by the school improvement team, which met to assess progress based on standards and objectives set forth by the state of Michigan and those outlined in the academy's charter contract. The 2021-2022 ABTE Continuous School Improvement Plan (MiCip) detailed one (1) Goal to be the focus for the year. This goal was: (1) Improve Literacy Proficiency. There are two (2) strategies that the Academy will focus on. The strategies are: (1) Essential Instructional Practices Grade K-3 and (2) MTSS - Literacy (Reading). The Academy will achieve this goal by 6/30/24. The plan is reviewed on an ongoing basis along with continuous review of the curriculum. Faculty, parents, students and staff members were

encouraged to submit feedback to the school improvement team for formal discussion.

3. A brief description of each specialized school

The Academy for Business & Technology Elementary School is a public charter school located in Dearborn, MI. We are chartered by Eastern Michigan University and serve students in grades kindergarten through fifth grade. Our curriculum and class offerings meet the State of Michigan requirements and strive to prepare students for success after graduation. Our school is distinctive, designed specifically to meet the existing and emerging needs of our community. The Academy for Business & Technology offers the following:

- High expectations for academics and behavior
- Personalized student attention
- Caring, highly qualified teachers
- · Hands-on, relevant learning
- Safe, nurturing environment

The Academy for Business & Technology utilizes various available curriculum and resources to meet the rigorous expectations of the Common Core State Standards (CCSS). These resources aid the teachers in planning, instructing, and assessing the students to ensure mastery of all core subject areas. The curriculum is available in the school office. The teachers and staff at the Academy for Business & Technology use the process of backwards planning to create instructional units that are organized in a developmentally appropriate and purposeful sequence. The resources that The Academy for Business & Technology uses are aligned to the CCSS for English Language Arts and Mathematics. The Academy for Business & Technology also uses resources aligned to the new Michigan Science Standards (MSS) for instruction in Science. For Social Studies, they are aligned to Michigan's Grade Level Content Expectations (GLCE). All resources are located in the Staff Resource Binder for easy access for all staff members. Below are some of the resources that the Academy for Business & Technology uses to support the Understanding by Backwards Design process.



What has been the performance trend in English Language Arts at ABTE over the last five years?




Percentage of Students Scoring in Proficient Levels M-STEP Spring 2018 thru Spring 2022


