To the Families of the Academy for Business & Technology,

On Thursday, March 12, 2020, Governor Whitmer announced that in order to slow the spread of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) in Michigan, all K-12 schools will be closed starting on Monday, March 16 until Sunday, April 5. The health and well-being of our families and community is our top-priority. We understand the concern and uncertainty you may be experiencing surrounding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and we are committed to being responsive to the needs of our families as more information becomes available.

We are working to ensure that our students and families have the support they need. To that end, we are closely monitoring guidance from all state and federal agencies to ensure the safety of our school community.

In addition to following CDC guidance and partnering with local health departments, we have heightened our cleaning and disinfecting procedures to maintain a healthy environment for our building and busses. We have instructed anyone who is not feeling well to stay home out of an abundance of caution.

School buildings are scheduled to reopen on Monday, April 6 which is the start of our scheduled spring break. At this time, we plan on honoring our spring break April 6th - April 10th, but this may change depending on the direction from the State of Michigan. With this in mind, students will be out for the next 4 weeks which means they will be missing instruction. In order for learning to continue, we are required to come up with a plan of action. Teachers created ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies packets for each grade level that should be completed in the next 4 weeks. **Please be aware that these packets MUST be turned in when students return.** It is important that students continue to learn and review at home, especially with the upcoming state tests. Please note that if students do not complete the assignments, it will create gaps in their learning. It is critical that we work together to educate our children.

In addition to providing these learning packets, we will be providing lunches to our students at each bus stop. A schedule will be shared with you to indicate
